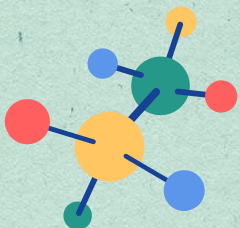

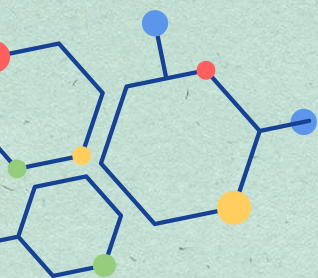

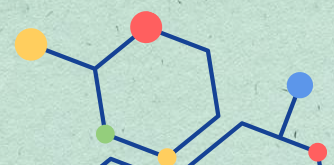
**Stéphane Monfils**
